Discussion was held regarding the upcoming Back to School Bash on Saturday, July 29, 2006. We will need help from every parent in order for this to be a successful fundraiser. The BASH will be held at Lakeview Park from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Plans include an inflatable jumping area for small children, a 45 foot water slip-n-slide, a 65 foot rock-climb with slide and obstacle course, a dunking booth, carnival games area, entertainment, silent auction and cook out. Unsure as to what the cost should be per person. We will be asking local companies to donate items for the silent auction and to sponsor the inflatable jumping area, 45 foot water slip-n-slide and 65 foot rock climb with slide and obstacle course.

Discussion was held regarding Nashville Concessions – LP Field. The Car Show was not worked as we did not have enough people sign up to work. Sign up sheets will be available for each event (soon to be on website). 18 people are needed for each event. Of those 18, 8 **must** be TIPS trained. Ratio can be 12 adults to 6 kids, but no less than 12 adults. TIPS training dates are June 20, 27, 28, July 11, 12, 25 26 and August 1 and 2. Starts at 6:00 p.m. and is a minimum of 3 hours. Cost is \$20 per person which is charged to us. TIPS certification is good for 3 years. Any student working **must** be 16 years of age with photo identification – no exceptions.

Still need band forms turned in and notarized.

Discussion was held regarding items still needed for Band Camp. Those items are: 2 big powdered containers of Gatorade/Powerade, aloe, sunscreen, bug bite medicine, Tylenol, Motrin, Band Aids and sandwich bags for ice.

Discussion was held regarding the upcoming Ice Cream Social for the Downtown Dickson Merchants on July 8th, from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. 10 – 12 students are needed to scoop ice cream.
